With reference to your office letter No. EDN-HE (21) F (09) 07/2018-Drug Abuse dated 13.12.2018, wherein you asked for a action taken report, it is informed that the college undertook the campaign against drug abuse on a large scale and following activities were undertaken: -

- 1. **Firstly**, the college administration constituted a two members committee consisting of Dr. Ravinder Chauhan and Dr. Deepak Kaprate to undertake and oversee all the activities related to Drug Abuse in the college.
- 2. The college started a series of lecture on the "**Drug Free Himachal**" and on 06.09.2018, Police H.P. Sh. S.R .Mardi delivered a lecture on the "**Legal Aspects of Drug Abuse**". On this day in another lecture, Principal IGMC,

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Workshop on Personality Development

Report

Two day workshop held on 12-13 December, 2019

Resource Person: Dr Kamayani Bisht: Associate professor in English: GC Theog

Two day workshop was conducted for final year students of NSS and NCC units of the college. The workshop was jointly coordinated by Dr Meenakshi Sharma and Lt Dr Poonama Verma. The workshop was attended by 260 volunteers, cadets and rovers and rangers of the college. The Resource person, Dr. Kamayani Bisht from Govt. College Theog said, personality development refers to the process of enhancing and improving one's personal and professional traits, such as communication skills, confidence, leadership, time management, and emotional intelligence. A well-developed personality can help individuals build better relationships, make positive impressions, and achieve success in their careers.

She said the most important objectives of the workshop were:

Improved communication: Developing effective communication skills can help individuals express their ideas and thoughts clearly and confidently, which is essential for building relationships and advancing in their careers.

Enhanced confidence: A well-developed personality can help individuals feel more confident in their abilities, leading to better performance in their careers.

Leadership skills: Developing leadership skills can help individuals manage teams, motivate employees, and make strategic decisions in their careers.

Time management: Improving time management skills can help individuals prioritize tasks, meet deadlines, and achieve their goals in their careers.

Emotional intelligence: Developing emotional intelligence can help individuals manage their emotions, understand others' perspectives, and build positive relationships in their careers.

During the two days of the workshop, some activities that she engaged the students with were:

Icebreakers: She started the workshop with icebreaker activities to help participants get to know each other and feel more comfortable including introductions, group games, and team-building exercises.

Self-assessment: Gave personality tests, skill assessments, and goal-setting exercises to participants to complete a self-assessment to identify their strengths and weaknesses.

Role-playing: Used role-playing exercises to help participants practice effective communication and interpersonal skills. These included scenarios related to conflict resolution, giving feedback, and making presentations.

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Group discussions: Organized group discussions to teach and demonstrate learning and knowledge-sharing among participants to encourage leadership, time management, and emotional intelligence.

Feedback sessions: Conducted feedback sessions for participants to give and receive feedback from each other. This included peer evaluations, constructive criticism, and positive reinforcement.

Problem-solving exercises: Did problem-solving exercises to help participants develop critical thinking and decision-making skills, like brainstorming sessions, and simulations.

Personal reflection: In the end, participants were given time for personal reflection to help them integrate their learning and insights into their daily lives. This was done through journaling, mindfulness exercises, and goal-setting activities.

Mindfulness exercises: meditation, deep breathing, and visualization to help participants reduce stress and improve focus and concentration.

Personal branding exercises: She trained participants to develop their personal brand, by defining their values, strengths, and unique selling points.

Public speaking exercises: Used public speaking exercises like extempore speaking, speech writing and delivery, and body language awareness to help participants improve their presentation and public speaking skills

Team-building exercises: Included team-building exercises that helped participants develop their teamwork and collaboration skills.

Creative exercises: encouraged participants to think outside the box and develop their creativity. This included storytelling exercises, and visioning activities.

Post workshop feedback gathered from the students shows that they enjoyed the interactive nature of the workshop and wanted more such fun-learning sessions to be conducted in the college.

Capacity Building Program on Soft Skills

A one-week capacity building workshop was organized from 09.08.2021 to 14.08.2021 by the IQAC for the benefit of teachers, non-teaching staff and students of the college. The course aims to create a basic awareness about the indispensability of soft skills at work place and in interpersonal communication and facilitate an all-round development of personality. To ensure the smooth conduct of the workshop, the following team was constituted:

On day one, in the inaugural session, Dr Kamayani Bisht set the context of the workshop by explaining the theme, scope and objectives of the workshop.

Dr Namrata Tikku (Retd. Principal), the resource person for the session introduced the concept of soft skills, types of soft skills and their importance. She emphasized the role of soft skills in effective classroom teaching. She said that the vast pool of graduated being dispatched into the society by the education system needs to be made more life-ready by training them in soft skills.

On day two, Ms Neelam Bali, who is a psychologist and counselor spoke about emotional intelligenceand its significance in the classroom and beyond. She gave examples from day to day experiences and her long experience as a psychologist to exemplify what emotional intelligence or the lack of it can achieve.

On day three, Ms. Nandini Pathania, Principal, St Bede's College spoke about non-verbal communication and how we can be a little more aware of our body language to be effective in our classroom communication and also in other interpersonal and social settings. She also spoke about the role of body language in public speaking. She included the importance of dress and touch in communication.

On day four Dr Poornima Chauhan spoke on leadership and conflict management. She spoke of the types of conflict; from intra to interpersonal, social to international. She also discussed conflict at workplace. She asked the participants to participate in a paper and pen response to show how our conflict resolution strategies can differ. She stressed on the role of empathy as well as sympathy, of introspection and of appreciation in resolving matters.

On day 5, Prof. Aman Sharma, Department of Computer sciences, HP University spoke on Technology and Communication: Netiquette and etiquette in the use of ICT. He listed things that

should be totally avoided while using the internet. He also spoke of concepts like stocking, identity theft, phishing and hacking.

Day 6, the last day had Prof Vikas Dogra, Chairperson, department of Journalism and Mass communication, HP University spoke about the barriers to communication. He also threw light on how written communication can be made more precise, sharp and relevant without having to compromise itsaesthetic value.

The Workshop was attended by 63 members of the teaching and non teaching staff. 117 students of the NSS units attended this workshop. Based on the feedback from the attendees, the workshop seems to have served its purpose to a large extent. Teachers, who felt they already knew the significance of interpersonal skills, were happy to be reminded that they may have been insensitive and ineffective, even though inadvertently. Students were the most benefitted by the workshop. They were given quick checklists and questionnaires to evaluate their understanding of what effective skills are and where they stand on the scale of social effectiveness. They reported that it had been a valuable learning experience for them.

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
