ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

B.A., B.Sc, B.Com-1st Semester: Passed 10+2 with 55% marks in aggregate (General Category)
Passed 10+2 with 50% marks in aggregate (SC/ST Category)

B.A/B.Sc./B.Com-2 & 3 year: 50% marks (Without any Compartment) in previous class

1. The admission shall be made purely on the basis of merit as per allocation of seats in each class or subject - combination.
2. Admission shall NOT be given to a student with compartment in 10+2.
3. Any student seeking admission to B.A. 1st Semester with Mathematics as one of the subjects of study, must have Mathematics as subject at 10+2 level and must have secured a minimum of 45% marks in this subject.

RELAXATION FOR SC/ST STUDENTS

1. Relaxation of three years of age for determination of upper age limit for admission to SC/ST shall be given.
2. The students belonging to SC/ST will be given 5% relaxation of marks for admission purpose i.e. minimum 50% marks in aggregate in 10+2 are required.
