ANNUAL REPORT 2018-19

Anti- drug abuse committee

The College is committed to fight against the menace of drug abuse. To achieve this objective and undertake activities related to drug abuse, the college constituted a two-member committee consisting of Dr. Ravinder Chauhan and Dr. Deepak Kaprate. The Committee carried out the following activities during the Session 2018-19:

- The Committee initiated a series of lectures on the 'Drug Free Himachal' since the beginning of the Session. The first lecture of the series was arranged on 6th of September, 2018 on the 'Legal Aspects of Drug Abuse' which was delivered by Sh. SR Mardi, DG Police, Himachal Pradesh.
- The second lecture of the series 'Drug Free Himachal' was delivered by Dr. Ravi C. Sharma (Psychiatric Department) Principal, IGMC, Shimla on 7th September, 2018.
- A counselling session was organized for the students who were caught red handed taking drugs and other addictive substances. Two MBBS doctors from Psychiatry Department of IGMC, Shimla were invited to counsel and motivate the offenders.
- On 15th December, 2018 one day workshop on drug abuse was organized. This workshop was conducted by clinical Psychologists Dr Deepa Rathore and Medical social worker Meenakshi Mehta both were from Deen Dayal Upadhya Hospital, Shimla. Through their lecture and video film negative effects of drug abuse were highlighted. "Say no to drugs" was the clear message of the session.
- The Committee has created a Whatsapp Group named 'Self Confidence' where the addicted students are constantly counselled.

Himrashmi 2018-19

The Career Counselling and Placement Cell of the College facilitates and guides the students about their career options after their graduation. The Cell organises many programmes for the students regarding awareness about their career and placements in collaboration with other institutions to inculcate the competitiveness among the students. We organized programmes with Chitkara University, Chandigarh University, Chankya Academy and Bright Academy on career opportunities after graduation. From this year, the cell has also facilitated the process of campus placement of students through various agencies. Educare of British Council selected 12 students for Internship Programme. South Indian Bank conducted an online test in the College for placement in their bank. Jio Communication has also organized Job Fair in the College Campus.

Disaster Management Cell

- 16th- 21st August, 2018, Three-Day Workshop on 'Disaster Risk Reduction' was held by The Disaster Management Cell in collaboration with State Disaster Management Authority Himachal Pradesh and Shimla based Non-Government Organization, DOERS. The volunteers from RED CROSS, NCC, NSS, Rangers & Rovers units of the college were selected for this workshop to gain some practical knowledge .The chief guest of this event was Dr. Sadhna Thakur, wife of Honourable Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh.
