The Anti-Drug Awareness Committee of the Centre of Excellence, Government College Sanjauli, Shimla, in collaboration with Prajapita Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwa Vidyalaya, Shimla, organised an Addiction-Free Awareness & National Addiction-Free Pledge Programme on 27 August 2026 in the Mathematics Room. The programme was attended by around 200 participants.

Sister Durga from Brahma Kumaris, Shimla, was the resource person for the programme. She sensitised the participants to the harmful physical, mental, emotional and social consequences of substance abuse. She emphasised self-discipline, positive thinking, emotional wellbeing, strong moral values and healthy lifestyle choices as important means of preventing addiction.

During the interactive session, students were encouraged to stay away from intoxicating substances and to inspire their friends, families and communities to adopt a healthy and addiction-free lifestyle. The session also highlighted the role of young people in creating awareness and contributing to a responsible and drug-free society.

An important component of the programme was the Addiction-Free Pledge. The participants resolved to remain free from intoxicants and to contribute towards building a healthy and Nasha-Mukt society.

The programme witnessed enthusiastic participation and reinforced the College's continuing commitment to drug-abuse prevention, student wellbeing and value-based education.
