the unit actively participated in the Integration Ceremony, which highlighted unity in diversity.

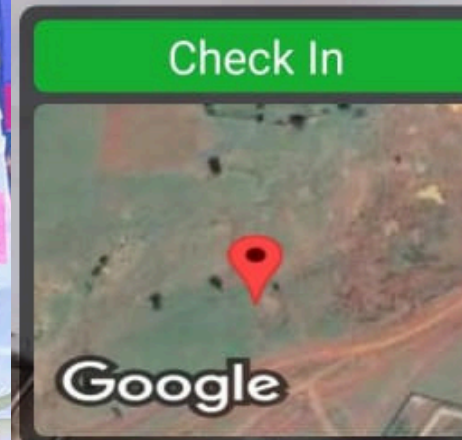
Our Rangers shared their cultural traditions, languages, and regional practices.

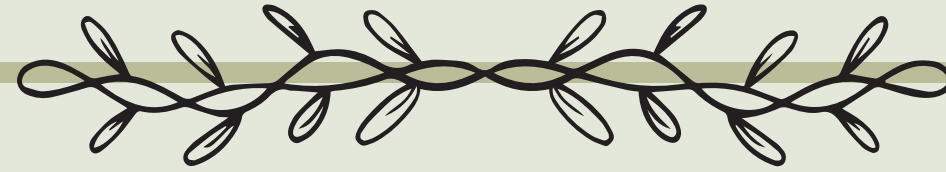
