

Report on the Program Held at the Centre of Excellence, Government College Sanjauli on the Occasion of World Tourism Day on 26,27 September 20224



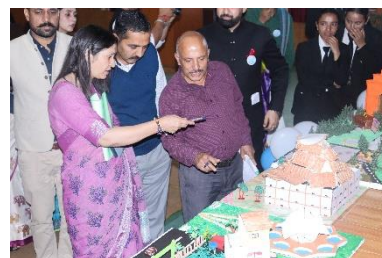
Peace and Tourism: Peace is the foundation of any country's development and prosperity. When a country is peaceful, its citizens feel safe, harmony prevails in society, and people can live their daily lives without fear or worry. Peace not only brings internal stability but also creates a favourable environment for external investment and trade. The event organization for 26th and 27th September 2024 included a structured plan with designated responsibilities. On 26th September, Suraj Jamalta and Sandeep Sharma supervised events such as Declamation, Quiz, Painting, Model Making,

and Chart Paper Making. For Tourism Day on 27th September, three committees are established to manage various aspects of the event. The Culture Committee, consisting of Pankaj Verma, Ramesh Bisht, Sheetal Kanwar and Shivani Shaw, handled stage setup, managed technical requirements, and coordination with speakers. The Refreshment Committee, including Umesh Rana, Shweta Thakur, Anuradha, and Minakshi handled food arrangements, dietary requirements, and timely service of refreshments. Lastly, the Stage Decoration and Seating Committee, led by Uma Kanwar, Surbhi Sharma, and Shweta Thakur ensured the venue was prepared, managed logistics, and managed the overall layout for smooth execution. On September 27, 2024, World Tourism Day was celebrated at the Centre of Excellence.

The purpose of this event was to promote the importance of tourism among students. The Principal of the college, faculty members, and students from various departments were present at the event. The chief guest, Prof. Bharti Bhagra and other guests were welcomed by the Nodal Officer Prof. Meenakshi Sharma who also delivered a speech about tourism. The program commenced with the lighting of the lamp by the honourable chief guest. Various cultural activities were organized during the event, such as dance performances, skits, speeches, modelling, quiz competition. In the quiz competition, **Ajay and Tushar** secured first position, **Priyanka and Preeti** secured second position while **Prem and Jaswinder** came third. In the speech competition, **Rabina** secured the first place followed by **Alisha** in second place. songs by Meenakshi, a theatre performance titled "Tradition and Responsibility", a modelling presentation showcasing different states, Hip-hop dance by Nikita and Bhoomika, a hip-hop song by Tushar and Tanishk, and folk music by the music department. Notable attendees at the event included Dr. Naresh Verma, Prof. Deepak Keprate, Prof. Himani Saxena, and Prof. Bharti Sharma along with other faculty members. The exhibition of charts and models was also organized as part of the ceremony and was a special highlight where students displayed pictures of various tourist destinations. Additionally, tourism-related items were showcased. The event concluded with a speech by the Principal and a prize distribution ceremony.
