

FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2022-23

Student's feedback

The majority of students expressed satisfaction with the college's curriculum and syllabi. They find them well-designed and suitable for their academic needs. Students generally believe that the teachers effectively deliver the syllabus during the academic session, with high-quality teaching methods. A small percentage of students had some concerns about the syllabus not meeting their expectations, indicating room for improvement.

Students appreciate the teaching techniques used by teachers, though a minority find the teaching aids to be inadequate. The assessment and evaluation system is generally perceived as fair but there is a small group of students who think they could be improved. Students express a desire for more experiential learning opportunities, such as internships, workshops, seminars, and field trips.

Suggestions from Students:

1. Promote activities that enhance critical thinking, argumentative skills and experiential learning.
2. Utilize smart classrooms more frequently.
3. Facilities and infrastructure for sports need to be enhanced

Parents' Feedback:

Parents are generally satisfied with the college's academic and extracurricular activities, as well as their children's safety and non-discrimination. They appreciate the mentor program and find the content delivery and evaluation system to be reasonably satisfactory. They are satisfied with content delivery and transparency. Parents suggest redefining and redesigning courses to align with evolving market demands, making them more competitive and creative.

Teachers' Feedback:

Teachers are moderately satisfied with the prescribed syllabi/curriculum, but there are mixed feedback regarding flexibility and participation in curriculum decisions. Many teachers believe that courses should be designed more democratically, with increased teacher involvement in syllabus development. Teachers have varying opinions on

whether the syllabi have enriched their own knowledge, but most agree that they have moderately enriched themselves through the teaching process.

Alumni Feedback:

Most alumni find the syllabi relevant and beneficial for their careers. Alumni appreciate the holistic development opportunities provided by the college. Their views on the transparency of evaluation systems and student-centered initiatives are mixed but have improved in recent years.

Suggestions from Alumni:

Encourage research oriented activities among students.

Regular up gradation of syllabi to match prominent institutions.

Make sports a mandatory part of the curriculum.

Incorporate more skill-oriented programs to prepare students for self-employment.

Actions Taken:

1. Feedback was analyzed and shared with the principal and staff council.
2. The IQAC planned activities for the upcoming year based on the feedback.
3. Department-wise plans for student-centric learning activities were requested from teachers.
4. Virtual guest lectures by experts from various fields were organized to diversify student exposure.
5. Technological upgrades for more ICT usage were done
6. Introduction of additional skill development courses was initiated.
7. The college is upgrading its sports facilities with synthetic turf for volleyball and basketball.
8. An arts block is being expedited to provide more interactive classrooms.
9. The existing Principal's residence has been demolished to make way for new construction.
