In the meeting of the IQAC, convened in the staff room at 02:00PM the following decisions were taken:

- Since the second wave of Covid-19 has pushed the students indoors, the outgoing batches of students have not had the opportunity to interact with the Career Guidance & Placement all. A major dip in the employment Market calls for new alternatives and preparation for career option.
- 2. The placement cells will co-ordinate a series of webinars to guide students to seek alternative career options and explore small independent initiations.
- 3. The women cell will offer online counseling for gender specific issues, since it has been apprehended that gender violence is on the rise during the lock down.
- 4. Mental health needs to be addressed actively. The college will engage a psychologist for personal counselling every fort night. Students can put in a request to Dr. Kamayani Bisht for an appointment with the counsellor.
- 5. In case the college re-opens by the year end, covid-appropriate preparation will be ensured by the specially constituted committee to oversee sanitization and social distancing. The committee will prepare another micro plan in keeping will the direction of the state government.
