E-GOVERNANCE POLICY DOCUMENT

Policy Purpose and Objectives: The aim of this policy document is:

- To ensure effective implementation of e-governance across all the functions within the college.
- To review, replace, complement and/or supplement the erstwhile physical governance infrastructure with e-Governance facilities for improving the efficiency of various functions within the college.

The Centre of Excellence Government College Sanjauli, Shimla-6 has made significant progress in implementing and integrating e-governance systems across various departments. This Annual E-governance Report outlines the key e-governance tools, platforms, and initiatives that have been implemented during the 2018-2023, covering the Administration, Finance and Accounts, Student Admission and Support, and Examination departments.

1. Administration:

The administration department has successfully integrated various e-governance systems to improve efficiency and transparency. These include:

- 1.1. *Manav Sampada:* This Human Resource Management System (HRMS) has streamlined the management of employee records, leave, attendance, service records, and various other HR functions.
- 1.2. *E-service Book*: The digital service book has replaced traditional paper-based records and allows faculty and staff to easily access and update their service records online.
- 1.3. *E-salary:* The E-salary system has facilitated the digital processing and disbursal of salaries, ensuring timely and error-free payments.

- 1.5. Education Management System (High Alt Education): This platform has been implemented to manage academic activities such as course planning, timetable management, and attendance tracking.

2. Finance and Accounts:

- 3.5. *SOUL Software for University Libraries:* This software enables students to access library resources and services online, including searching for books and reserving study spaces.
