This immersive involvement enabled students to understand both the **creative** and **organizational** aspects of an international film festival.





3. Learning Environment and Exposure

7. Conclusion



SUBJECT: STUDENTS' PARTICIPATION AS VOLUNTEERS- 10TH IFFS.


