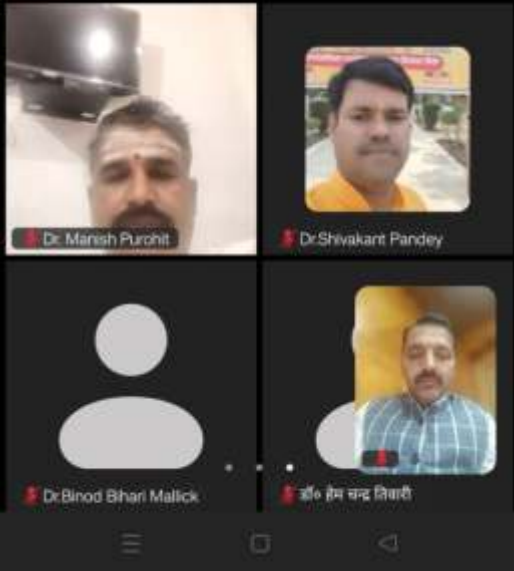

## *Missed but not forgotten*

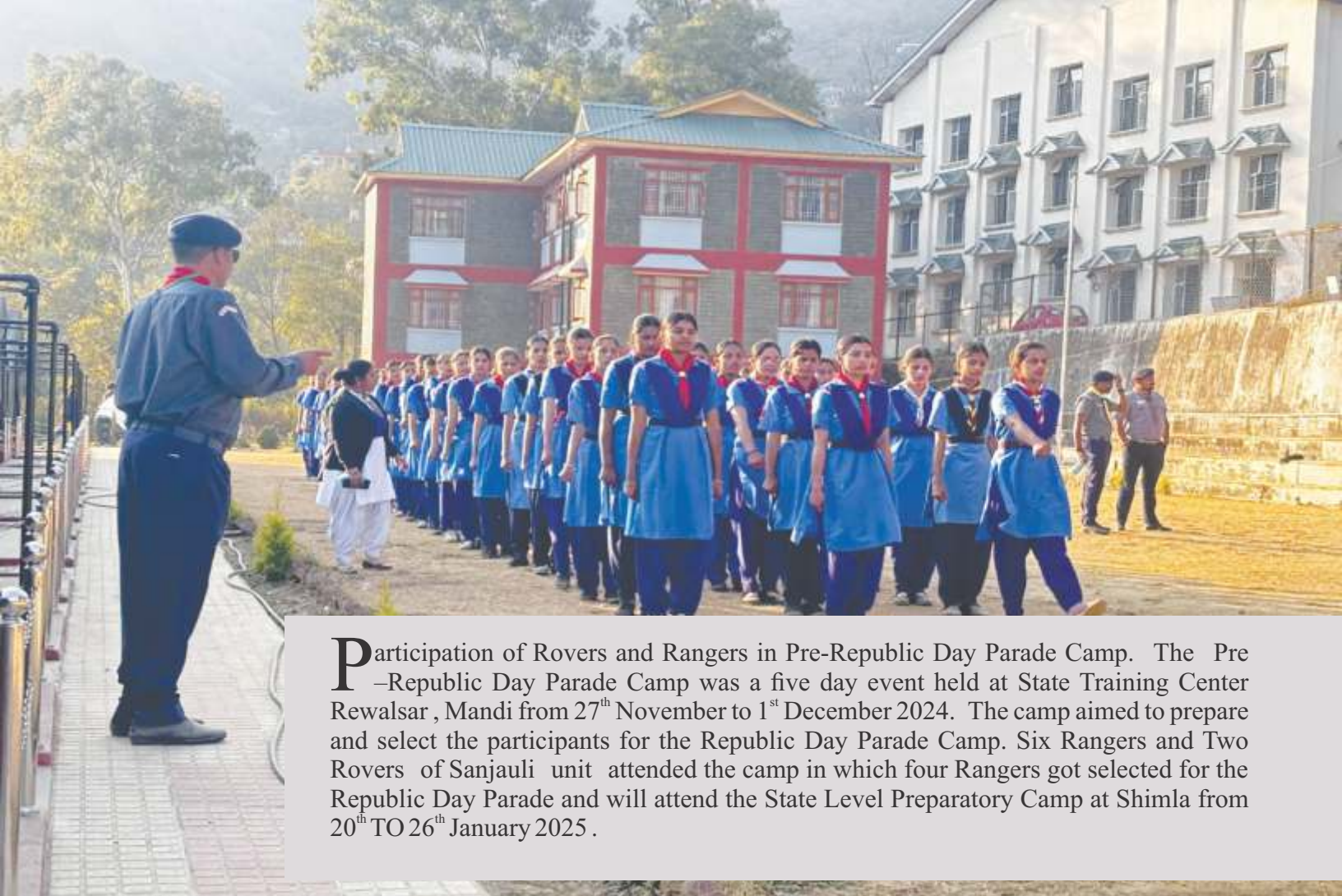
