DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION ACADEMIC EVENT 2025-26

On September 25th, 2025, the Department of Public Administration at the Centre of Excellence, Government College Sanjauli, hosted an academic event featuring Debate, Declamation, and Poster Making competitions. The Chief Guest for the occasion was the Principal, Prof. Bharti Bhagra, who, in her speech, commended the dedication and enthusiasm displayed by the students of the Public Administration Department. She encouraged them to engage regularly in such academic pursuits and to provide guidance on the topics related to debate and declamation.

The judging panel for all three competitions included Prof. Prashant Thakur, Assistant Professor of Sociology, Dr. Anupama Singh, Assistant Professor of English, and Dr. Arun Sharma, Assistant Professor of Hindi. The event was successfully overseen by Dr. Purnima Thaper and Dr. Saroj Negi, both Assistant Professors in the Public Administration Department.

Approximately 250 students from the Public Administration program, spanning BA 1st, 2nd, and 3rd years, attended the event, significantly uplifting the spirits of all participants. The Debate competition centered on the topic "The Role of Media in Portraying Feminism," with Team B emerging as the winner, consisting of members Harshita, Surbhi Thakur, and Sneha. Additionally, Satakshi Thakur from Team A was recognized as the Best Speaker.

In the Poster Making competition, Jiya (B.A. 1st Year) secured third place, Monika (B.A. 3rd Year) took second place, and Surbhi Thakur (B.A. 2nd Year) achieved first place.
