A Report on

A successful **Blood Donation Camp** under **Mission Raktanjali** was jointly organized on 1st October 2025 by the **Rotaract Club, Centre of Excellence Government College Sanjauli, and the Rotary Club Shimla, in collaboration with IGMC Shimla**.
