Free Eye Check-Up & Spectacles Distribution

The Rotaract Club of Government College Sanjauli, in collaboration with Rotary Club Shimla, organized a special Vision Plus free eye check-up and spectacle distribution camp on 23rd September 2025 at the college campus. The program was formally inaugurated at 10:00 AM by the Principal, Prof. Bharti Bhagra, who graced the occasion as the Chief Guest. The successful organization of the camp was made possible through the collective efforts of Prof. Rita Chandel, Convener of the Rotaract Club, and Rtn. Karan Bamba, President of Rotary Club Shimla.

The primary objective of the camp was to provide free eye check-ups for college students, teachers, and staff members, and to distribute spectacles to those in need. A team of specialist doctors conducted examinations throughout the day, while more than 20 Rotaractors actively participated in managing the camp. They guided participants through the check-up process and assisted in distributing spectacles. The camp, which continued until 4:00 PM, benefitted a large number of participants. Over 250 individuals underwent eye examinations, and more than 70 were provided with free spectacles.

In addition, the initiative successfully raised awareness about the importance of regular eye care among students, staff, and the local community. The event was further enriched by the presence of college faculty members Dr. Minakshi Sharma, Dr. Mona Sharma, Dr. Poonam Chandel, and Dr. Lakhbeer Singh, along with Rotarians Mr. Amit Sood and Mr. Manu Aggarwal, who extended their support to the camp.

The Vision Plus camp not only provided immediate healthcare benefits but also reflected the commitment of both the Rotaract Club of Government College Sanjauli and Rotary Club Shimla towards community service and public health awareness.
