EVENT PROCEEDINGS

The Installation Ceremony was conducted in a precise, formal sequence according to standard Rotaract protocols, as outlined below:

1. **Opening and Welcome Address:** The Master of Ceremonies officially opened the grand installation ceremony under the theme "सृजन," extending a warm welcome to respected Rotarians,

12. **Adjournment and Fellowship:** The newly installed Charter President, Rtr. Vineet Ronta, officially called the meeting to a close. The floor was then opened for final closing remarks, fellowship, and refreshments.
