



Policy on Disabled-Friendly Barrier-free Environment at G.C. Sanjauli

Government College Sanjauli recognizes the importance of providing a barrier-free environment that is accessible to all, including people with disabilities. To contribute towards this goal, the college has formulated the following policy on disabled-friendly barrier-free environment:

Accessibility:

The college will ensure that all buildings and facilities on campus are accessible to people with disabilities. Monitoring and Reporting:

The college will monitor accessibility and report progress towards barrier-free goals to the concerned authorities. This will include regular inspections of the campus to identify any accessibility barriers and taking corrective action to remove them.
