INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

REPORT OF REVIEW MEETING (SESSION 2024–25)

- The IQAC reviewed the progress of decisions taken during the academic session 2024–25 and noted that the **Self-Assessment Report (SAR)** was successfully prepared and submitted on time, reflecting coordinated institutional efforts.
- All departments actively participated in maintaining **updated and verified academic, administrative, and infrastructure data**, ensuring accuracy and transparency in institutional records.
- Preparations for the **Faculty Development Programme (FDP)** on “*Redefining Pedagogy and Integrating ICT in Teaching*” were reviewed, and it was observed that necessary arrangements had been made in advance.
- There has been a noticeable improvement in **ICT-enabled teaching practices**, including the use of digital tools, smart classrooms, and outcome-based education methodologies, making the teaching-learning process more effective.
- Academic support initiatives such as **coaching for IIT-JAM and UGC-NET**, along with **mentor-mentee and peer learning systems**, have been successfully implemented to support students academically.
- The institution has taken proactive steps in organizing **pre-admission counselling and outreach activities**, helping prospective students make informed choices and improving enrolment quality.
- Faculty members have been encouraged to actively engage in **research activities**, including undertaking projects, publishing papers, and exploring opportunities for patents.
- Initial steps have been taken towards establishing a **research laboratory under the DBT Star College Scheme**, though the work is still in progress and requires further attention.
- Departments have contributed to academic enrichment by organizing **seminars, workshops, and various scholarly activities**, enhancing the overall academic environment of the college.
- Efforts have been initiated to develop **collaborations through Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs)** with reputed institutions; however, this area requires further progress.
- The development of a **digital repository and regular updating of departmental web pages** has shown positive progress, improving access to academic resources and information.
- Student-focused initiatives such as **experiential learning opportunities, scholarship facilitation, and participation in academic activities** have been strengthened to ensure holistic development.
- Plans for organizing **inter-college events and national-level seminars** have been prepared, aiming to increase academic exposure and institutional visibility.
- The IQAC has maintained **continuous monitoring and quality checks**, ensuring that institutional practices remain aligned with NAAC and UGC guidelines.
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- While most of the planned resolutions have been successfully implemented, some initiatives—particularly **MOUs and the research laboratory setup**—are still ongoing and need timely completion.
- The committee emphasized the need to further strengthen **research output, interdisciplinary programmes, and student engagement** in the coming session.
- The Chairperson appreciated the sincere efforts of all members and encouraged them to complete the remaining tasks within the stipulated time. The meeting concluded with a formal vote of thanks to the Chair.

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
