



Plan of Action for achieving goals

The action plan for achieving the Vision, Mission, and Institutional Development Plan (IDP) of Government College Sanjauli is designed to systematically strengthen academic quality, research orientation, infrastructure, and student-centric development in alignment with NEP 2020. The institution will focus on transforming the teaching-learning process through the implementation of CBCS, introduction of interdisciplinary and skill-based courses, and integration of ICT-enabled pedagogies such as smart classrooms and Learning Management Systems. Regular Faculty Development Programs, workshops, and training sessions will be conducted to enhance teaching competencies and promote the use of innovative and experiential learning techniques. In addition, a strong emphasis will be placed on building a research ecosystem by establishing research and innovation cells, encouraging faculty publications, supporting student research projects, and promoting academic collaborations at national and international levels. Infrastructure development will be undertaken in a phased manner, including the expansion of digital classrooms, modernization of laboratories, strengthening of library resources through digitalization and e-journals, provision of campus-wide high-speed internet, and completion of key infrastructure projects such as the Arts Block, Girls' Hostel, and Professional Courses Block. Simultaneously, student support systems will be reinforced through efficient scholarship disbursement, structured skill development programs in collaboration with agencies like HPKVN, career counseling and placement services, and active engagement in NSS, NCC, sports, and other co-curricular activities to ensure holistic personality development.

Furthermore, the plan places significant emphasis on enhancing employability, governance, community engagement, and sustainability to ensure balanced institutional growth. Strong industry-academia linkages will be developed through Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs), facilitating internships, industrial visits, hands-on training, and placement opportunities, along with the establishment of entrepreneurship and innovation platforms to nurture startup culture among students. Administrative reforms will focus on strengthening institutional bodies such as IQAC, NAAC, and NIRF committees, promoting transparency through e-governance, and ensuring participatory decision-making involving all stakeholders, including faculty, students, alumni, and the community. The institution will also expand its role in social responsibility through NSS-led outreach programs, awareness campaigns, and community



development initiatives, particularly in nearby rural areas, thereby contributing to regional development. Environmental sustainability will be promoted through systematic waste and e-waste management practices, adoption of renewable energy sources such as solar power, expansion of rainwater harvesting systems, and regular green initiatives like plantation drives and environmental awareness campaigns. To ensure effective implementation, a robust monitoring and evaluation framework will be established through clearly defined Key Performance Indicators (KPIs), periodic reviews by IQAC and academic bodies, and continuous feedback from stakeholders. This comprehensive and integrated approach will enable the institution to achieve its vision of becoming a benchmark of quality education while fostering intellectual excellence, social responsibility, and holistic development among students
