



# ACADEMIC AUDIT REPORT

## Govt. Degree College Sanjauli, District Shimla

### Examination Results Analysis 2024-2025

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#### **Institutional Context and Scope**

This Academic Audit Report presents a comprehensive and analytical evaluation of the examination results and academic performance of Govt. Degree College Sanjauli, District Shimla, for the academic year 2024-2025. The college, as an NAAC-accredited Grade 'A+' institution affiliated with Himachal Pradesh University, has demonstrated commendable commitment to academic excellence across a diverse portfolio of academic programmes spanning undergraduate (BA, B.Sc., B.Com), professional (BBA, BCA, B.Voc), postgraduate (MA in Hindi, Economics, English, and Public Administration), and diploma programmes (PGDCA).

The present audit encompasses examination results data from 1,339+ students across multiple disciplines, representing the cumulative academic performance across six semesters during the 2024-2025 academic cycle. This holistic assessment provides an evidence-based evaluation of institutional effectiveness, quality assurance mechanisms, and the overall academic health of the college.

#### **Institutional Performance Overview**

The examination results across all programmes reveal a robust and consistent pattern of academic excellence, with institutional pass rates ranging from 79.90% to 100% across various programmes and years of study. More significantly, the percentage of students achieving grades 'A' and above (typically comprising A, A+, A++, O, O+, O++, and S grades) demonstrates sustained high-quality learning outcomes across all disciplines. The college's achievement of 80% of students securing A-grade and above across professional programmes (BBA, BCA, B. Voc, MA, and PGDCA) represents a considerable strength and reflects the institution's pedagogical effectiveness and student engagement strategies.

#### **Key Findings and Systemic Strengths**

##### **1. Undergraduate Programme Excellence**

The undergraduate programmes—BA, B.Sc., and B.Com—constitute the largest component of the college's academic operations, serving over 1,100 students across all three years of study. The BA Programme, with 556 final-year students, demonstrates exceptional outcomes with 97.30% pass rate and 96.04% of students achieving A-grade and above. The performance profile reveals that 213 students secured the highest grades (A++, O, O+), while only 2 students faced failures. This trajectory reflects consistent quality maintenance across all three years, with BA II exhibiting 94.94% pass rate and BA I scoring 95.67% pass rate.

The **B.Com** Programme presents the most remarkable performance metrics, with **B.Com** III achieving a perfect 100% pass rate, **B.Com** II at 97.40%, and **B.Com** I at 91.78%. The consistency of high-level performance (100% of students in **B.Com** III achieving A-grade and above) with zero failures indicates robust curriculum design, effective teaching-learning processes, and strong student-faculty engagement. The department's recognition on the University Merit List, with five students securing top positions (including the University Topper from the college), substantially validates the quality of instruction and institutional support systems.

The **B.Sc.** Programme, while demonstrating lower pass rates in first and second years (80.25% and 79.90%, respectively), shows significant improvement in the final year with 93.27% pass rate. The presence of 131 students achieving A++-and-above grades in **B.Sc.** III demonstrates capacity for advanced-level learning among a substantial cohort of science students, notwithstanding the challenges inherent in quantitative discipline coursework.

## **2. Professional Programmes: BBA and BCA Performance**

The BBA Programme, serving 251 students across six semesters, demonstrates 91.26% overall pass rate with 229 students passing and only 22 requiring reappearance. Grade distribution analysis indicates that approximately 64% of students across all BBA semesters achieved grades A and above, reflecting solid pedagogical outcomes. The Programme shows consistent performance trajectory, with final-semester (VI) results indicating 88.89% pass rate and meaningful concentration of students in higher grade categories (B+ through O+).

The BCA Programme, established as a professional computing discipline, exhibits similar performance patterns with 175 total students across six semesters and an aggregate pass rate of 85.39% (152 passed, 18 reappeared). The Programme demonstrates particular strength in final semesters (V and VI), with 90.70% pass rate in Semester V and 97.73% in Semester VI. The presence of 82 students passing in final semesters with only 5 requiring reappearance suggests enhanced student maturity, improved learning outcomes, and potentially better integration of capstone/project-based learning in upper semesters. Grade distribution indicates concentration in A+ and A grades, aligning with industry expectations for computing professionals.

## **3. Postgraduate and Professional Development Programmes**

The college's postgraduate departments—spanning MA Hindi, MA English, MA Public Administration, MA Economics, and PGDCA—collectively serves 140+ students with uniformly high performance standards. The MA programmes demonstrate near-universal achievement of grades A and above, with many students securing O+ and O grades. Specifically:

- **MA Hindi** shows 100% pass rate with 70% of students achieving O-grade and above
- **MA Public Administration** demonstrates 100% pass rate with significant concentration in A++ and above grades

- **MA English** reflects consistent high performance with majority of students securing A+ and above grades
- **PGDCA (Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications)** maintains 100% pass rate with distributed performance across A-grade categories

These outcomes underscore the college's commitment to advanced learning and specialized professional development, providing graduates with credible qualifications for competitive labour markets.

#### **4. B. Voc Programme and Skill-Based Education**

The Bachelor of Vocational (B. Voc) Programme, serving 145 students across six semesters with 67.59% overall pass rate, represents the college's engagement with skill-based, industry-oriented education. While pass rates are moderate (particularly in first and second years), the Programme design with substantial practical training components, industry partnerships, and competency-based assessment appears aligned with vocational education pedagogy. The programme's presence reflects institutional responsiveness to evolving higher education needs and student aspirations toward technical and vocational competencies.

#### **Strategic Implications and Quality Indicators**

The holistic performance metrics presented in this audit reveal several key indicators of institutional quality:

**Pass Rate Consistency:** Across all major programmes, pass rates consistently exceed 79%, with undergraduate programmes averaging above 93%, demonstrating effective academic support mechanisms and curriculum appropriateness.

**Excellence Metrics:** The concentration of students achieving A-grade and above (ranging from 79% in **B.Sc.** to 100% in **B.Com III**) significantly exceeds typical institutional benchmarks and suggests rigorous assessment, well-designed pedagogy, and substantive student engagement.

**Zero-Failure Commitment:** Multiple Programme-year combinations demonstrate zero or minimal failure rates, indicating proactive student support, early intervention mechanisms, and potentially heightened teacher awareness of struggling learners.

**University Recognition:** *The achievement of five B.Com students on the University Merit List, with one securing the University Topper position, validates the quality of college instruction within competitive university-wide assessment frameworks.*

#### **Structural Quality Elements Inferred from Results**

The consistent patterns of high performance across diverse programmes suggest underlying institutional strengths in several critical dimensions:

1. **Curriculum Design:** Well-articulated curriculum aligned with learning outcomes and disciplinary standards

2. **Faculty Expertise:** Appropriately qualified and engaged faculty demonstrating effective pedagogical practices
3. **Teaching-Learning Resources:** Adequate library, laboratory, computing, and instructional resources supporting learning
4. **Student Support Systems:** Effective academic mentoring, counseling, and remedial support services
5. **Assessment Practices:** Rigorous, fair, and transparent assessment mechanisms generating reliable performance data
6. **Institutional Governance:** Leadership committed to continuous quality improvement and evidence-based decision-making

### Conclusion: Institutional Academic Health Assessment

The examination results data presented in this audit, encompassing over 1,339 students across 12+ distinct academic programmes and representing diverse disciplinary fields, collectively demonstrate robust institutional academic health. The sustained high pass rates, significant concentration of students in higher grade categories, and recognition on university merit lists position Govt. Degree College Sanjauli as a quality teaching institution effectively fulfilling its mandate of providing accessible, affordable, and high-quality higher education to the region.

This audit establishes a baseline for continued institutional improvement efforts. While maintaining current strengths, the college should direct strategic attention toward: (1) systematic analysis of the factors contributing to varied performance across Programme-years to identify replicable best practices, (2) targeted support for programmes with lower initial-year pass rates, (3) documentation and dissemination of successful pedagogical interventions, and (4) strengthening of industry linkages for vocational programmes.

The audit affirms the college's demonstrated commitment to academic excellence while providing a framework for continued institutional development and enhanced stakeholder accountability.



# BA Programme Results Analysis

Out of 556 students who have appeared in final year examination of BA III only 13 students got compartment, 2 students failed only 6 students passed with B+ grade, 1 student passed with B grade and 534 students have passed with A and above A grade.

Also Students with A++, O and O+ Grade are around 213 and with S grade we have 6 students in BA III.



Out of 624 students of BA I 24 students got compartment, only 03 got failed, 16 passed with B+ grade and only 4 passed with B grade. Rest of them passed with A or above A grades. With around 173 students with A++ and above grades.

Out of 632 students of BA II year who have appeared in final examination 26 students got compartment, 6 students were failed, 14 students got B+, 1 student got B grade, and rest 585 students passed with A and above A grade. Around 203 students passed with A++ and above grades.



# BSc Programme Results Analysis




