Students of Department of Zoology, Government College, Sanjauli participated in Centre for Science, Learning, and Creativity (CSLC) Science Museum, Shoghi, organized comprehensive APICULTURIST (WILD-BEE)-GSDP, GREEN SKILL DEVELOPEMENT PROGRAMME by 13th-31st May, 2025. Fourteen students from Government College Sanjauli participated enthusiastically in this initiative.

INTRODUCTION

- 'The programme commenced with an introductory session led by *Dr. Gyan Chand Verma*, who provided an in-depth overview of apiculture and the ecological significance of honey bees. This was followed by a detailed presentation by *Dr. S.P. Bhardwaj* on the life cycle of honey bees, various products derived from beekeeping, and the characteristics of different honey bee species, including Apis indica and Apis mellifera.



- LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT-

The students also benefited from the expertise of *Mr. Kapil Sharma*, Founder of Mind Story Creations Pvt. Ltd., who delivered transformational sessions on professional mentoring, executive coaching, entrepreneurship development, digital marketing strategies, and network marketing advisory. These sessions aimed to empower students with leadership skills and practical knowledge.





PRACTICAL LEARNING

A field survey was conducted in Baldeyan and Rohru, where students gained hands-on experience in beekeeping practices. They observed bee colonies in wooden, log and mud hives, learned about the uses of bee wax, and witnessed the process of honey extraction and purification.

The programme culminated in a cultural event where students shared their experiences and expressed their newfound interest in apiculture. The participants appreciated the blend of theoretical knowledge and practical skills acquired during the programme, which has sparked their enthusiasm for this field.
